

Bet365 vs William Hill: 2026 comparison

Bet365 vs William Hill 2026 — odds, racing, In-Play, streaming, app and offers compared. Which UK bookmaker offers more for sports punters.

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TL;DR Bet365 and William Hill are two of Britain's best-known bookmakers, both UKGC-licensed and long-established. Bet365 leads on live streaming, In-Play depth and overall market breadth, making it the stronger all-round online account. William Hill brings deep racing heritage, a long high-street presence and a familiar, trusted brand, appealing to punters who value its racing roots and the option of betting in shops as well as online. Offers and prices change constantly, so treat the detail as typical and confirm the current terms on each operator's official site. Both are legitimate, regulated choices; the right one depends on what you value. 18+; terms apply; begambleaware.org.

Licences and reliability

Both are UKGC-licensed, long-established and trusted, with full safer-gambling tools. William Hill adds a long high-street heritage; on trust the two are level.

As with any comparison, safety comes first, and both clear the bar easily. Bet365 and William Hill are each licensed by the UK Gambling Commission, so the same protections apply.

- **Both UKGC-licensed:** regulated to the same standards on fairness, fund protection and anti-money-laundering.
- **Heritage:** William Hill is one of the oldest names in British bookmaking; Bet365 a digital-era giant trading since 2000.
- **High-street presence:** William Hill operates betting shops as well as online, a point of difference.
- **Player protection:** both offer deposit limits, time-outs and self-exclusion as licence conditions.

On reliability there is nothing meaningful to separate them. Both are major, financially solid operators that pay winnings and run stable platforms, and either licence can be confirmed on the UKGC public register — see our licence and safer gambling guide.

William Hill's high-street heritage is a genuine differentiator for some punters: the ability to bet in a shop, collect winnings over the counter, or simply the comfort of a brand on the local parade. For purely online punters it matters less, but it speaks to a long, trusted history. The choice, then, comes down to product and what you value, not safety.

Both are UKGC-licensed and trusted; William Hill adds high-street heritage, but on safety the two are level — fit decides it.

Odds and margins

Both price competitively across key markets, with racing concessions on each side. Bet365 has broader market depth; William Hill is strong and familiar on racing and football.

On odds, the two are closely matched, sitting in the competitive band and trading the lead depending on the market. Neither is a clear winner across the board.

Bet365's edge is breadth — more markets per event and deeper niche coverage, as our odds and margins guide sets out. For punters who bet beyond the obvious markets, that depth is a real advantage and means you can usually find your angle.

William Hill is strong and reliable across the key markets, with a particular familiarity in racing and football born of its long history. Its racing concessions and well-established markets make it a comfortable, competitive choice for those staples, even if its overall range is not as vast as Bet365's.

The honest position on price is that neither wins decisively, and the keen value-hunter should hold both and compare. For most punters the odds gap is marginal, and the decision turns more on product, racing strength and the high-street option than on price alone.

Both price competitively with racing concessions — Bet365 wins on breadth, William Hill is strong on racing and football staples; compare for value.

Racing and In-Play

William Hill brings deep racing heritage; Bet365 counters with Best Odds Guaranteed, In-Play depth and a streaming library William Hill cannot match.

Racing is William Hill's traditional heartland, while In-Play and streaming are Bet365's. This section is where the two brands' characters are clearest.

- **William Hill racing heritage:** a long, trusted history in racing, with familiar markets and a high-street presence at the track and on the parade.
- **Bet365 racing offer:** full UK and Irish coverage with Best Odds Guaranteed and festival concessions — see our racing guide.
- **Bet365 streaming:** a large library of streamed events, including racing, watched alongside the bet slip.
- **Live betting depth:** Bet365 keeps more markets open In-Play with fast, stable pricing.

For racing, both are really strong, and the choice is more about flavour than quality. William

Hill carries the weight of heritage and the high-street option; Bet365 matches it on concessions like Best Odds Guaranteed and adds racing streaming and deep In-Play. A racing purist may lean to William Hill's tradition, but Bet365's offer is fully competitive and more integrated with watching the action.

On In-Play and streaming more broadly, Bet365 has the clear advantage. Its streaming library and live-betting depth, covered in our In-Play guide, exceed what William Hill offers. If watching and betting together — on racing or anything else — is central to you, Bet365 is the stronger pick.

William Hill owns racing heritage; Bet365 matches it on concessions and adds streaming and In-Play depth — the broader pick for watch-and-bet punters.

Offers and apps

Both apps are capable and well established. Bet365's carries the full product including streaming; William Hill's is solid and familiar, with its own promotions.

The app and the promotions round out the comparison, and both operators field mature, capable products with their own character.

- **Bet365 app:** feature-rich, carrying the whole sportsbook, In-Play and streaming — see our app guide.
- **William Hill app:** a solid, familiar app covering the full range, refined over years.
- **William Hill offers:** a rotation of football, racing and acca promotions.
- **Bet365 welcome offer:** a Bet Credits structure with ongoing promotions across the sportsbook.

Bet365's app is the more feature-dense, because it carries the streaming library and the full breadth of the sportsbook in one place. That makes it busier but more capable, and for streaming and In-Play it is the obvious home. William Hill's app is a mature, dependable product that does the job well across betting and racing, with a long-refined feel.

On promotions, both are competitive, each running football, racing and acca offers that rotate over time. Neither has a decisive edge; the difference is more in the surrounding product than the offers themselves. As always, judge any promotion on whether it improves a bet you were making anyway rather than on the headline.

Both apps are capable and mature; Bet365's is busier but carries streaming and the full product, William Hill's is solid and familiar.

Verdict

Bet365 for streaming, In-Play and breadth; William Hill for racing heritage and the high-street option. Hold both if you can; otherwise pick by what you value.

Both are excellent, legitimate UK bookmakers, so the verdict is about fit. Match the strengths to how and what you bet.

- **Choose Bet365 for:** live streaming, In-Play depth, the widest market coverage and

one thorough online account.

- **Choose William Hill for:** racing heritage, a familiar trusted brand, and the option to bet in shops as well as online.
- **Hold both if you can:** compare odds market by market and use each for its strengths.
- **Recommendation:** for all-round online betting, Bet365 edges it; for racing-led punters who value heritage and the high street, William Hill is a strong choice.

If forced to pick one all-round online account, we would lean to Bet365, because its streaming and In-Play depth and its market breadth give it a clear, hard-to-match advantage online. Our full Bet365 verdict details who it suits.

That is not a knock on William Hill, which remains a first-class bookmaker with deep racing roots and the unique option of a high-street presence. For a racing-focused punter, or anyone who values betting in a shop, it may really be the better fit. The pragmatic answer for many is to hold both, take the better price each time, and use each for what it does best. Whatever you choose, bet within a budget you can afford to lose and use the safer-gambling tools.

Bet365 edges it online for streaming, In-Play and breadth; William Hill wins on racing heritage and the high street — hold both if you can.

Does William Hill have live streaming like Bet365?

Not to the same extent. Bet365's live-streaming library is far larger, covering many sports watched alongside the bet slip, with deep In-Play markets, statistics and Cash Out. William Hill offers live betting, but if watching and betting together is central to you, Bet365 has a clear advantage on streaming volume and integration.

Can I bet with William Hill in a shop?

Yes — William Hill operates betting shops on the high street as well as online, which is a

genuine point of difference from the online-only Bet365. For punters who value betting in person, collecting winnings over the counter, or the familiarity of a local shop, that high-street presence can be a deciding factor in William Hill's favour.
